

Scheduling A Visit

All visitation appointments must be scheduled **at least 3 days in advance** through Signup Genius. <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/msal>

- COVID testing is not required but **is highly recommended** prior to your scheduled visit.
- No visitors under the age of 18 are permitted at this time.
- NO PETS will be permitted at this time unless it is a Service animal that has been cleared through Cody Christian, Healthcare Administrator.
- Visitors are required to sign the Visitation Policies Agreement Form prior to or upon arrival.
- Failure to comply with these policies may lead to access denied to the community.

Upon Arrival for Your Visit All Visitors Must:

- Check in with the AccuShield Kiosk at the Designated Entrance and answer screening questions.
 - If visitors answer “YES” to any of the screening questions, they will NOT be permitted to access the community.
- Accept a temperature check upon entry to community,
 - Visitor will not be permitted access beyond the concierge desk if temperature is greater or equal to 100.4 F.
- Wear their daily AccuShield badge, (must be visible at all times), while on campus.
- Concierge will provide you with a face mask and face shield. This must be put on immediately.
- Concierge will provide you with a guest fob in exchange for your I.D card in order to enter the neighborhood. All first-time visitors will be greeted by a staff member and escorted to the resident room.



- Please ensure to sign into the visitor's book located outside the doors of the elevator.
- Please ensure to use hand sanitizer before and after your visit.
- Limit movement to and from the resident's room/apartment ONLY
 - No visitors are permitted to remain in common areas, including Dining Rooms, sitting areas in lobbies, and activity rooms
- Maintain at least 6 ft. physical distance unless the resident is fully vaccinated in which they can choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor.
- Follow universal standard precautions, which include but not limited to personal protective equipment (PPE) surgical masks, face shields and proper hand hygiene before and after visit.
